### 8 Wheeler Transporter - New Headboard, Deck & Hydraulic Ramps

When Nigel from Kensington Mini Diggers came to us with his project we were only too willing to take it on board.  
 With the help of our Engineer and many professional suppliers we were able to take Nigel's 8 wheeler, which once moved cattle, and transformed it into this Transporter capable of moving loads of up to 12 tonne with ease.  
 With the addition of a head board /load anchors the full length of the deck, strengthening of the deck to chassis mounts and gussets to help hold it firm.  
 The important part of any descent transporter is at the back! By trimming the deck and adding 2.5 metres of slopping deck and new chassis rails we were able to mount two generous ramps on the newly fabricated dove tail.  
 A 24 volt hydraulic power pack means the lifting and lowering of these rams is a breeze.

All in all this project is something we all here at Onsite Engineering are proud to be a part of.
